### CRITERIA FOR WINTER RIDE DISCOUNTS

Criteria for participants of Organization/Group listed above to qualify for Winter Ride discounts on lessons, rentals and/or lift tickets or season passes is as follows:

1. Group size and requested dates must be approved by Mt. Baker. Minimum group size of 20 participants.
2. Only Minor participants in grade 2–12 qualify for Winter Ride discounts. Saturday and One Day Programs for grades 6-12 ONLY.
3. The Coordinator/Leader designates one qualified chaperone each day on the mountain to be the primary representative and available for contact in the event a participant is injured or is involved in behavior requiring disciplinary action (which may include loss of skiing/snowboarding privileges).
4. Chaperones and/or adult volunteers may be entitled to discounted or complimentary lift ticket (as determined by Mt. Baker) if they meet the following criteria:
  - a. Meet chaperone/volunteer requirements of the Organization/Group,
  - b. Meet qualifications of WA RCW 43.43.830 and RCW 9A.72.085, and
  - c. The Coordinator/Leader confirms that Chaperones/Volunteers meet the criteria and supplies Mt. Baker a list of qualified chaperones.
  - d. Mt. Baker reserves the right to impose reasonable limits on the number of chaperones that will be provided with discounted/complimentary lift tickets.

## CRITERIA FOR WINTER RIDE DISCOUNTS (continued)

5. In an effort to facilitate ski patrol mountain closures at the end of the day, the Coordinator/ Leader will supply an authorized Mt. Baker Ski Area representative with a sign out sheet indicating that all participants and members of the Organization/Group who were on the mountain that day have been accounted for before departure from the ski area.
6. The Organization/ Group will distribute to the participants any Trail Maps, mountain policies, or safety information provided to the Coordinator by Mt. Baker as soon as such information has been provided.

### MT. BAKER SKI AREA, INC. **WINTER RIDE PROGRAM MEMORANDUM of AGREEMENT**

In the interest of promoting youth with access to the winter mountain environment, Mt. Baker will provide certain discounted products/services to youth Participants enrolled in the Winter Ride Program. The discounted products/services provided by Mt. Baker are listed on the Participant Enrollment Form. All other products/services associated with the Winter Ride Program will be provided by the registered organization/group.

1. Mt. Baker Ski Area provides discounted Season Passes, Lessons, and/or Rentals for Participants enrolled in the program through a registered Winter Ride Organization/Group depending on what Winter Ride program the Organization/ Group qualifies for. These are the ONLY services provided by Mt. Baker to participants enrolled in the Winter Ride Program.
2. Mt. Baker DOES NOT provide or assume any responsibility for transportation. All transportation services associated with the Winter Ride Program are the responsibility of the registered organization/group.
3. Mt. Baker DOES NOT provide or assume any responsibility for supervision or guidance of Winter Ride participants outside of a regularly scheduled instruction class.
4. Payment will be made to Mt. Baker for Season Passes, Lessons and/or Rentals as described in Participant Enrollment Form.
5. All visitors to Mt. Baker Ski Area are subject to all Mt. Baker Ski Area Mountain Policies and Guidelines.
6. Participants renting equipment from Mt. Baker at the discounted rates available to Winter Ride Participants are subject to all Mt. Baker policies and procedures that apply to all other guests renting equipment from Mt. Baker.
7. Any Winter Ride services offered to Participants in the Winter Ride Program other than discounted Season Passes, Lessons, and/or Rentals are not the responsibility of Mt. Baker Ski Area.
8. Participants enrolled in the Winter Ride Program and their parents/legal guardians, as well as Chaperones/Volunteers and Coordinators, are required to sign Mt. Baker's Winter Ride Release Agreement in order to qualify for the services provided by Mt. Baker as part of the Winter Ride Program.

The registered Organization/Group named in this agreement agrees to RELEASE, INDEMNIFY and HOLD HARMLESS Mt. Baker Ski Area, Inc., its owners, land owners, directors and officers, employees, sponsors, and agents ("Mt. Baker") from any and all claims related in any way to participation in "Winter Ride" activities at the ski area or any other mountain activities, as well as use of Mt. Baker ski area facilities, services and/or equipment, including any and all claims for death, personal injury, property damage, theft, financial loss, or actions of any kind including negligence.

## SIGN HERE

It is understood that Mt. Baker Ski Area is not affiliated with any other entities, organizations, groups, clubs or persons involved in the coordination or organization of transportation of individuals to the Mt. Baker Ski Area and/or related activities. This RELEASE/INDEMNIFICATION clause shall be construed broadly to provide INDEMNITY and RELEASE OF LIABILITY to the maximum extent permissible under applicable law. This RELEASE AGREEMENT is governed by the Laws of the State of Washington and venue for any disputes regarding this AGREEMENT and/or use of the Mt. Baker Ski Area facilities, services, and/or equipment will be in the Superior Courts of Whatcom County. If any part of this RELEASE is deemed unenforceable, all other parts shall be given full force and effect.
