Mt. Baker SnowSchool is an unforgettable winter adventure that combines hands-on science education with snowshoe-powered outdoor exploration for grades 6-12 at the Mt. Baker Ski Area. During a one-day field trip, students explore and learn about the winter mountain environment in a way that directly compliments classroom curricula. In small groups (approximately a one-to-six instructor/student ratio) with trained interns and volunteers (this could be you!) students learn about: our public lands and watershed, winter ecology, snow science, mountain safety and winter recreation.

- Work directly with middle and high school students
- Teach students outdoors at the Mt. Baker Ski Area
- Promote a healthy & active lifestyle through winter recreation
- Receive professional education and mountain safety training
- Eligible for skiing & boarding benefits at the Mt. Baker Ski Area

Entry into the program is on a first-come, first-served basis. This is a part-time, volunteer opportunity. Instructors are responsible for providing their own food, housing, health insurance and transportation. Shuttle and carpooling possibly available.

Academic credit for internship hours available. It is the responsibility of the intern to complete any necessary internship paperwork with their university to receive credit.
